Whether you're planting for the first time or want to better equip those you plant, you're invited to join us for a Church Planting Workshop. Workshops are day-long equipping sessions featuring a high level of personal interaction hosted at The Summit Church in Raleigh-Durham, NC.

Participants receive an in-depth look at the philosophy and strategy of planting gospel-centered churches with the goal of starting or improving their own church-planting programs. Workshops will address questions like:

- How can we establish a sending culture at our church?
- Which planting model best fits our church and context?
- How do we identify and develop future planters?
- Should we start a residency program?
- What makes a good residency program?

A few years ago we were a church that wanted to plant but wasn't sure how to do it. So we gleaned from other churches and started trying things. Over the years we've definitely had some hiccups but God has graciously given us the privilege of sending out two hundred and thirty-eight people to plant twenty-three churches in North America.

We're a partnership of churches (some we've planted and others we haven't) that share one vision and three distinctives. **Our vision** is to plant *1,000 churches in our generation by training leaders* while each network church is committed to **three distinctives**: *Gospel, Balance, and Multiplication*.
